MBoutik creates products from fabric handwoven on 100 shuttle looms. We use both organically dyed cotton and colour for traditional Myanmar ethnic designs as well as creating our own unique designs bringing new life to old traditions.

MBoutik is a social enterprise initiative of ActionAid Myanmar (AAM).

Through the Socio Economic Development Network Program (2013 to 2017) women from the Dry Zone of Myanmar were trained in artisan crafts of weaving, tailoring, jewelry making and rattan and connected to form Producer Support Groups.

Today, these women producers have formed their own Craft Producer Association.

Petrified wood jewellery

Rattan is a sustainable climbing plant grown in the Dry Zone of Myanmar and used by our artisans to weave a range of pots, bowls, boxes, mirrors, and plates. Either in natural product or interwoven with colourful ribbon, all create vibrant artistic pieces for your home or office.
