The Bali Process Regional Support Office (RSO) was established in 2012 to provide technical support to Bali Process Members and to strengthen regional cooperation on refugee protection and international migration, including human trafficking and people smuggling. The RSO is the only cooperation mechanism of its kind in the region.

We provide support to Bali Process Members to improve aspects of migration management, responses to people smuggling, trafficking in persons and related transnational crime.

We engage and promote the work of the RSO to partners and dialogues outside of the Bali Process architecture, and publicly advocate on our issues and activities.








